## LEAF-NELSEON

On your next walk, watch out for colorful autumn leaves. With them, you can make your very own cute Leaf-Nelson! Here's how:

### YOU WILL NEED:

- ✓ Autumn leaves
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Glue stick
- ✓ String
- ✓ Colored pencils
- ✓ PDF template



### INSTRUCTIONS:

**STEP 1:** Go outside and collect some pretty, colorful leaves. Make sure they are dry and clean. To dry them, put the leaves between newspaper pages. If they curl, place a few books on top – this keeps them nice and flat.

**STEP 2:** Print out our Nelson template and color Nelson's face with your colored pencils.

**STEP 3:** Cut off the stems of the leaves. Then carefully cut out Nelson's head along the outer line. Tip: Use slightly thicker paper – it works best!

**STEP 4:** Put plenty of glue on the back of the template. Stick the leaves around Nelson's head so they look like a mane.

**STEP 5:** Want to hang up Nelson? Carefully make a small hole at the top of his head with scissors. Then thread a string through it.

**Now your Leaf-Nelson is finished!**
