## NELSON'S EASTER BASKET

Feel like making a colorful Nelson Easter basket? We'll show you how to make one and what you'll need!

- One sheet of construction paper in your favorite color
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Lord Nelson template (printable)
- Decorative and filling materials



### HOW IT WORKS:



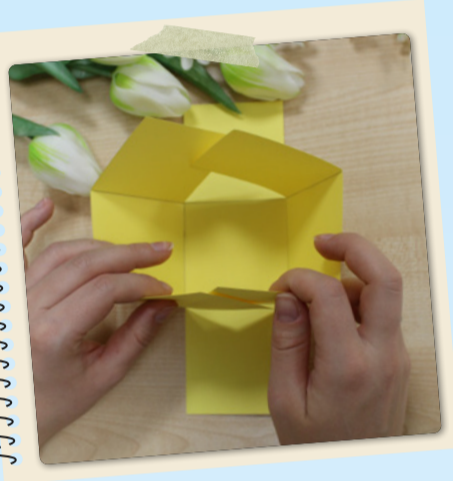
**STEP 1:** Cut a square (21 x 21 cm) from a colored sheet of construction paper. Please keep the leftover paper – you'll use it to make the handle.

**STEP 2:** Using a ruler and pencil, divide the square into nine equal squares (each 7 x 7 cm).

**STEP 3:** Follow our template and cut along the marked lines accordingly.

**STEP 4:** Fold the two side sections inward, then fold the outer flaps over.

**STEP 5:** Glue the overlapping areas with a glue stick. Tip: Don't glue perfectly straight – a slight angle looks better, as shown in the picture.



**STEP 6:** Take the remaining construction paper from Step 1 and cut a strip about 21 cm long and 4 cm wide.

**STEP 7:** Attach this paper strip as the handle of your Easter basket.

**STEP 8:** Next, glue the middle squares in place.

**STEP 9:** Color our Nelson template and carefully cut it out. Then you can stick Nelson onto the front of your Easter basket.



### DONE:

Now you can decorate your basket however you like and fill it with sweets or small surprises.
